What we have done:

- Submitted our planning application. Available to view on the Councils planning portal, reference 18/01467/GRG3.
- Submitted a planning application to develop the playing at the back of Hob Moor school, reference 18/01475/GRG3.
- Progressed the procurement for a building contractor.
- Submitted the section 77 to DfE to use part of Hob Moor School's surplus playing field.
- Our Architects and Interior Designer have held sessions with key stakeholders, parents and carers to talk through initial design ideas. Further sessions are booked through August to develop those ideas further.

What we plan to do next:

- Collate all feedback from interior design meetings to create final design principles.
- Engage children and young people, parent / carers and front line staff in developing the theme, artwork and name for the building.
- Progress the design stage of the building further, with more detailed plans to aid the construction phase.
- Work closely with the development of Lincoln Court (the older people accommodation next door) to ensure that when construction starts there is minimum disruption to local residents, community and school.
