The appointment will last 1 hour 30 minutes



The assessment team includes psychologists, mental health nurses and an occupational therapist.

When you arrive for the assessment 2 things will happen....

Parent meeting



Your parent/ carer will talk to a member of the assessment team.



We will talk about how **AMAZING** you are!!



We will also talk about some of the things you find difficult

We will ask some questions about when you were little and how things are now

Chat and play

You will go into another room with 2 other team members, but don't worry, your parent/ carer will be nearby!

We will do lots of things such as....



Play games



Do some puzzles



Read a book

Talk about school, home and friends

After this has finished you will leave and your parent/ carer will come back on a different day for feedback on the assessment.

Feedback



We will talk about the assessment within the team



We will look at the school forms that were sent back to us and any other information that may be important.

We will then meet with your parent / carer for 1 hour and we will

- Talk about what happened in the assessment
- Feedback the outcome of the assessment
- Talk about what will happen next
