What we have done

- Design principles, options and ideas have been consulted on with parents, staff and partner agencies. Feedback has been given to Gilling Dod Architect
- A potential land option has been identified and discussions have started about how this could developed in partnership with local services
- The overall financial business case has been developed, scrutinised and agreed
- Plans and proposals have been discussed with Council Chief Officers and elected members. They have given their support to continue to progress the plans and developments.
- Cllr Rawlings - Executive Member for Education, Children and Young People has been interviewed on BBC Radio York about the plans and vision for a Centre of Excellence.

What we plan to do next

- Gilling Dod will present final feasibility design options to key people in December
- A report with recommendations will be developed for Executive Elected Council Members to agree in January 2018
- A land option will hopefully be agreed and discussions with the local community and services will start to take place publically
