What we have done

- The Specialist Design Consultants (Gilling Dod Architects) have listened to and discussed the list of building requirements from staff, parents and partners. They have now started to develop some initial design ideas and options.
- There are 2/3 land options which are being looked at seriously and in detail with a view to having a preferred option agreed in principle in October.
- The Design Consultants will complete their feasibility work and present a recommended option in the middle of November.

What we plan to do next

- Discuss with parents, staff and partners initial design ideas and options and key decisions at a **drop in consultation session on 2nd October 11- 1330 at West Offices**
- Work out of the cost and implications of 'doing nothing' for children, parent / carers, staff and Council. This will then be used to support the case for the new building.
