Who we help:

Our team of advisers supports students with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) and who are in education and training.

We work with City of York students aged from 13 to 25 years who are at:

- secondary schools in York
- local and specialist colleges
- or are with personalised learning and training providers.

How we help:

We provide confidential and impartial information, advice and guidance to help to prepare young people to make choices and plan their futures. We advise on a young person's education and further learning options and their participation in society.

We begin by finding out about the young person's hopes and ambitions and can help them to make choices by arranging visits and taster sessions.

We offer information and advice to help parents and carers plan ahead for when the young person moves – or transitions - towards their next steps. As part of a student's EHCP review we offer support to the young people themselves, their families and carers before leaving school or college.

We also offer advice on and help to co-ordinate personalised learning programmes. These programmes offer educational alternatives for students who need a more flexible programme and venue.


Working closely with other members of the transition team, we support students to prepare for their next steps after school. Other transition team members include social workers, care managers and the York Independent Living and Travel Skills service (YILTS).
